## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A46 Trunk Road (Farndon, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road ("the A46"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Farndon, in the County of Nottinghamshire, should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Farndon, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 10th March 2014.

**2.** In this Order:

"Farndon Roundabout"		the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its pout junction with the B6166 and Fosse Road;	
"the trunk road"	means –		
	i)	the northbound carriageway of the A46 from a point 400 metres south of Farndon Roundabout, to a point 100 metres north of that roundabout;	
	ii)	i) the southbound carriageway of the A46 from a point 400 metres north of Farndon Roundabout to a point 100 metres south of that roundabout and	
	iii)	the circulatory carriageway of Farndon Roundabout;	

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, during the period starting at 00:01 hours on Thursday 13th March 2014 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this Order, no person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the trunk road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or special forces purposes; or
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
