### ROAD TRAFFIC

# The M42 Motorway (Junctions 9 to 6) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 20th January 2014

Coming into force - - 27th January 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway ("the M42") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway and three of those connecting roads, in the County of Warwickshire and the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M42 Motorway (Junctions 9 to 6) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 27th January 2014.

#### **2.** In this Order:

"the motorway"

means the southbound carriageway of the M42 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 9 to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 6;

"a link road"

means the link road leading -

- i) to the southbound carriageway of the M42 from the southbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 4a;
- ii) to the southbound carriageway of the M42 from the southbound carriageway of the M6 Toll, west of Coleshill; and
- to the southbound carriageway of the M42 from the northbound carriageway of the M6 at M42 Junction 7;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 3rd February 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or a link road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - 5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle
    - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
    - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
    - (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
