**The A52 Trunk Road and M1 Motorway (Borrowwash,
Derbyshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2014**

Made - - - - *8th April 2014*

Coming into force - *15th April 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road (“the A52”) and the M1 Motorway (“the M1”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Borrowwash, in the County of Derbyshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road and M1 Motorway (Borrowwash, Derbyshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Tuesday 15 April 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the first length of trunk road” means the westbound carriageway of the A52 from a point 500 metres east of the centreline of the Hopwell Road underbridge, to a point 400 metres west of the centreline of the Hopwell Road underbridge;

“the second length of trunk road” means the westbound carriageway of the A52 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the M1 at Junction 25, to its junction with Borrowwash Road;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the A52 from its junction with the M1 at Junction 25;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Tuesday 22nd April 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of trunk road or the slip road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of –

a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- i. being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or special forces purposes; or
- ii. proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and

b) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works
