ROAD TRAFFIC

The A405 Trunk Road (M1 Junction 6) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made--14th April 2014Coming into force-4th May 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A405 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A405 Trunk Road (M1 Junction 6) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 4th May 2014 and shall apply for a period of twelve months.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A405 Trunk Road (North Orbital Road) near Watford in the County of Hertfordshire;

"the motorway" means the M1 Motorway at Junction 6 in the County of Hertfordshire;

"works" mean cyclic maintenance and/or urgent repair work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of -

- (i) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 10th May 2014 or on any subsequent Saturday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 4th May 2014 or on any subsequent Sunday,
- (iii) 7¹/₂ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 5th May 2014 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday, or
- (iv) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 9th May 2014 or on any subsequent Friday,

until Sunday 3rd May 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to turn right -

- (a) from the northbound carriageway of the trunk road towards the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 6; or
- (b) from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road towards the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 6.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
