**The A1 Trunk Road (Denwick to Wandylaw) (Temporary
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *24th April 2014*

Coming into force - - *5th May 2014*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the County of Northumberland, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be restricted and prohibited because carriageway resurfacing works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Denwick to Wandylaw) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 5th May 2014.

2. In this Order: –

“the A1” means the A1 Trunk Road from a point 1350 metres south of the centreline of its junction with the B6347 at Charlton Mires to a point 430 metres south of the centreline of its junction with the local road to Preston at Brownieside, a distance of approximately 4940 metres;

“a layby” means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the A1 Trunk Road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00: hours on Tuesday 6th May 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 7 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the A1 at a speed exceeding:

- (i) 10 miles per hour whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those carriageways are displayed; or
- (ii) 40 miles per hour whilst such traffic signs in relation to those carriageways are not displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 7 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake another moving vehicle in the A1.

5. Subject as mentioned in article 7 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A1 Trunk Road at its junctions with the B6347 at Charlton Mires.

6. Subject as mentioned in article 7 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or wait in a layby situated adjacent to the A1 Trunk Road approximately:

- (i) 3000 metres north of its junction with the B1340 at Denwick Interchange;
- (ii) 240 metres, 670 metres or 1130 metres north of its junction with the B6347 at Charlton Mires; or
- (iii) 400 metres north of its junction with the local road at North Charlton.

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. Nothing in article 4, 5 and 6 shall apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to any vehicle being used for a purpose specified in paragraph (a) of this article;

and nothing in article 5 and 6 shall apply to any vehicle or person proceeding in the A1 to or from premises and property which is accessible for that vehicle, and only from, that road.

8. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
