The Urban Development Corporations in England (Area and Constitution) Order 2014

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 134 and 135 of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 26 to, the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980(1), makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Urban Development Corporations in England (Area and Constitution) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 31st March 2014.

Revocations

- **2.** (1) The following are revoked—
 - (a) the Thurrock Development Corporation (Area and Constitution) Order 2003(2);
 - (b) the London Thames Gateway Development Corporation (Area and Constitution) Order 2004(**3**); and
 - (c) article 2 of the WNDC Order.

(2) The West Northamptonshire Development Corporation (Area and Constitution) (Amendment) Order 2011(4) is revoked with effect from 31st July 2014.

(3) So much of the WNDC Order as has not been revoked is revoked with effect from 31st July 2014.
