The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Rendcomb Aerodrome) Regulations 2014

 Made
 2nd May 2014

 Coming into force
 11th May 2014

The Secretary of State had decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Rendcomb Aerodrome, Gloucestershire by reason of the holding of a flying display that is scheduled to take place there on 11th May 2014.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Rendcomb Aerodrome) Regulations 2014 and come into force on 11th May 2014.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3(1) all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time(**b**).

Restricted airspace

- **3.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 1500 hours and 1540 hours on 11th May 2014, no aircraft is to fly below 5,700 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 5 nautical miles whose centre is at 514652N 0015710W.
- (2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying with the permission of the flying display director at Rendcomb Aerodrome.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose a restriction on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Rendcomb Aerodrome, Gloucestershire, during a flying display by the Breitling Jet Team that is scheduled to be held there on 11th May 2014.

The restriction has been agreed by the Civil Aviation Authority and the Department for Transport for reasons of public safety and to protect the display team from other traffic.
