ROAD TRAFFIC

The A50 Trunk Road and M1 Motorway (M1 Junction 24a, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - 28th April 2014

Coming into force - - 5th May 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road ("the A50") and the M1 Motorway ("the M1") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of those roads and one of those connecting roads, at Kegworth in the County of Leicestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A50 Trunk Road and M1 Motorway (M1 Junction 24a, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 5th May 2014.

2. In this Order –

"Warren Lane Roundabout" means the circulatory carriageway of the A50 at its

junction with Warren Lane;

"the trunk road" means –

(a) the southbound carriageway of the A50 from its junction with Warren Lane Roundabout, to its junction with Church Street;

(b) the eastbound carriageway of the A50 from its junction with the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 24a, to its junction with Warren Lane Roundabout;

(c) Warren Lane Roundabout:

"the slip road" means the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 24a;

"central reservation" means that part of the trunk road which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular

traffic using that road;

"layby"

means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Sunday 11th May 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road or the slip road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through the gap in the central reservation adjacent to the trunk road.
- **5.** Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby situated adjacent to the trunk road.
- **6.** Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the trunk road at its junctions with the unnamed roads leading to and from the Hilton East Midlands Airport Hotel.
- **7.** The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- **8.** The provisions of
 - (a) articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
 - (iii) being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer; and
 - (b) articles 3 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicle proceeding to and from premises which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road;
