ROAD TRAFFIC

The A19 Trunk Road (Downhill Lane Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A19 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of South Tyneside, in the County of Tyne and Wear, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be prohibited because bridge repair works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A19 Trunk Road (Downhill Lane Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 16th May 2014.

2. In this Order:-

"the A19" means the A19 Trunk Road southbound carriageway between the nose of the southbound exit slip road and the nose of the southbound entry slip road at the A1290 Downhill Lane Interchange, a distance of 500 metres;

"the works period" means a period of:

- (i) 15 hours starting at 19:00 hours on Saturday 17th May 2014 or any subsequent Saturday night thereafter until the said works have been completed;
- (ii) 9 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Sunday 18th May 2014 or any subsequent Sunday night thereafter until the said works have been completed; or
- (iii) 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 19th May 2014 or any subsequent Monday night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order no person shall during the works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A19.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or

(c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
