ROAD TRAFFIC

The A34 Trunk Road (Wendlebury) (Closure of Lay-by) Order 2014

Made - - - - 19th May 2014

Coming into force - 2nd June 2014

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A34 Trunk Road (Wendlebury) (Closure of Lay-by) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 2nd June 2014.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A34 Trunk Road near Wendlebury in the County of Oxfordshire;

"lay-by" means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(**b**).

3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the lay-by in the northbound carriageway of the trunk road, 500 metres south of the M40 Junction 9 roundabout.
