### ROAD TRAFFIC

# The A5 Trunk Road (Brownhills, Staffordshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 6th May 2014

Coming into force - - 13th May 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5") is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Staffordshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Brownhills, Staffordshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Tuesday 13th May 2014.

#### 2. In this Order -

"Rising Sun Island" means the circulatory carriageway of the A5 at its

junction with the A452 Chester Road North;

"the trunk road" means the westbound carriageway of the A5 from its

junction with White Horse Road/The Parade, to its

junction with Rising Sun Island;

"the works period" means the period starting at 18:30 hours on Monday 19th

May 2014 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the trunk road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road.

- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - 6. The provisions of
    - a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;
    - b) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle
      - a. being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
      - b. proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
    - c) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle
      - a. being used in connection with the said works; or
      - b. proceeding to and from premises which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road.
