ROAD TRAFFIC

The A303 Trunk Road and A36 Trunk Road (Deptford Junction Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - - *20th May 2014*

Coming into force - - - - - *24th May 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A303 Trunk Road (“the A303”), the A36 Trunk Road (“the A36”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads at the Deptford Junction in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A303 Trunk Road and A36 Trunk Road (Deptford Junction Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 24th May 2014 and apply for a period of twelve months.

2. In this Order –

“the slip roads” mean (i) the A303 eastbound and westbound exit and entry slip roads at the A303 / A36 Deptford Junction; (ii) the A36 northbound and southbound exit slip roads leading to the A303 westbound at the Deptford Junction;

“the works” mean general maintenance works including road markings and surfacing;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 26th May 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the slip roads.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance purposes.
