

(f) exit slip road from the southbound carriageway of the A14(M) to Rusts Lane, Alconbury and

(g) entry slip road to the northbound carriageway of the A14(M) from Rusts Lane, Alconbury;

“works” mean safety fence tensioning, bridge inspections, surfacing, white lining, road stud replacement and sweeping;

“a works period” means a period of –

(a) 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 2nd June 2014 or on any subsequent day, other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday, or

(b) 9 hours starting at 21.00 hours on Friday 6th June 2014 or on any subsequent Friday, until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
