## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A52 Trunk Road (Spondon, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road ("the A52"), and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads, at Spondon in the County of Derbyshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Spondon, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 26th May 2014.

2. In this Order –

"the slip road"	means the slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A52 from its roundabout junction with the A6005 Derby Road (Spondon Roundabout);
"the works period"	means the period starting at 18:00 hours on Sunday 1st June 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to leave the eastbound carriageway of the A52 at its junction with Lodge Lane.

**5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The Provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
