The A46 Trunk Road (Winthorpe, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road ("the A46") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that trunk road and some of those connecting roads, at Winthorpe in the County of Nottinghamshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Winthorpe, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Friday 30th May 2014.

2. In this Order –	
"Eastern Roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its junction with the A1 and A17;
"Western Roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its junction with the A1 and B6166;
"Winthorpe Roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its junction with the A1133 and Drove Lane;
"the first length of trunk road"	 means the – (a) southbound carriageway of the A46 – i. from its junction with Eastern Roundabout, to its junction with Western Roundabout; ii. from its junction with Winthorpe Roundabout, to its junction with Eastern Roundabout; (b) Eastern Roundabout; (c) Western Roundabout; and

	 (d) northbound carriageway of the A46 from a point 500 metres north of Western Roundabout, to its junction with Western Roundabout;
"the second length of trunk road"	means the northbound carriageway of the A46 between its junction with Western Roundabout and its junction with Eastern Roundabout;
"a slip road"	 means the slip roads leading from the – (a) southbound carriageway of the A1, to its junction with Eastern Roundabout; and (b) northbound carriageway of the A1, to its junction with Western Roundabout;
"layby"	means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Tuesday 3rd June 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road or a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the second length of trunk road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby situated adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A46 190 metres south of Western Roundabout.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of –

- (a) articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle
 - i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (b) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes; and
- (c) articles 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
