ROAD TRAFFIC

The A30 Trunk Road (Monkton, Near Honiton, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - 6th January 2014

Coming into force - - 9th January 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road ("the A30"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Honiton in the District of East Devon in the County of Devon should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Monkton, Near Honiton, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 9th January 2014.

2. In this Order -

"the A30" means (i) the A30 westbound from its junction with Stockland Hill to the tip of the nosing of the westbound exit slip road at the A35 Monkton Road Junction, Honiton; and (ii) the A30 eastbound from the tip of the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at the A35 Monkton Road Junction, Honiton, to its junction with Stockland Hill;

"tip of the nosing" means the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean drainage repairs;

"a works period" means a period of 32 hours starting at 22.00 hours on Friday 10th January 2014 or on any subsequent Friday and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A30.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the A30;
- (c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
