ROAD TRAFFIC

The A52 Trunk Road (Spondon to Long Eaton, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made 9th June 2014 Coming into force -16th June 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road ("the A52") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that trunk road and some of those connecting roads, between Spondon and Stapleford in the City of Derby and the County of Derbyshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Spondon to Long Eaton, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 16th June

2. In this Order –

"the trunk road"

means the -

- (a) eastbound carriageway of the A52 from its junction with the slip road leading to the A5111 Raynesway and its roundabout junction with the A6005 Derby Road, to its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the M1 at Junction 25;
- (b) westbound carriageway of the A52 from its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the M1 at Junction 25, to its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the A6005 Derby Road;

"the slip road" means the slip road leading from the A6005 Derby Road roundabout to the trunk road;

means any side road which gives access to or from the trunk road;

"a side road"

"the works period"

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 23rd June 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road or the slip road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the trunk road at its junction with a side road.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
 - (c) being used in connection with the said works; or
 - (d) proceeding to and from premises which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road.
