ROAD TRAFFIC

The M4 Motorway (Junction 19 Eastbound Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 25th June 2014

Coming into force - - 28th June 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M4 Motorway ("the M4") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that carriageway and two of those connecting roads at Junction 19 in South Gloucestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the M4 Motorway (Junction 19 Eastbound Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 28th June 2014.
 - 2. In this Order -

"the circulatory carriageway" means sections of the circulatory carriageway at the M4 Junction 19 interchange roundabout;

"the slip roads" mean the eastbound exit and entry slip roads at M4 Junction 19;

"the works" mean replacing road lining;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 1st July 2014 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the circulatory carriageway and the slip roads.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
 - (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
