ROAD TRAFFIC

The M45 Motorway (Dunchurch – M1) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 28th July 2014

Coming into force - - 4th August 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M45 Motorway ("the M45"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that motorway in the Counties of Warwickshire and Northamptonshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M45 Motorway (Dunchurch – M1) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 4th August 2014.

2. In this Order -

"Dunchurch Roundabout"

means the circulatory carriageway at the roundabout junction of the B4429, A45 Daventry Road and the slip road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the M45;

"the motorway"

means -

- a) the eastbound carriageway of the M45 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to Dunchurch Roundabout, to its junction with the southbound carriageway of the M1 at M1 Junction 17: and
- b) the westbound carriageway of the M45 from its junction with the northbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 17, to its junction with the slip road leading from the A45 Daventry Road.

"the works period"

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 11th August 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the motorway.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
 - a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
 - b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable or traffic officer in uniform;
 - c) being used in connection with the said works or by, or with the permission of, a traffic officer in uniform.
