ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M50 Motorway (Junction 2, Bury Court) (Temporary
Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *7th July 2014*

Coming into force - - *14th July 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M50 Motorway (“the M50”) is satisfied that traffic on a length of that Motorway near Bury Court in the County of Gloucestershire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M50 Motorway (Junction 2, Bury Court) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 14th July 2014.

2. In this Order -

“the motorway” means the westbound carriageway of the M50 from a point 300 metres east of the centreline of the A417 Gloucester Road overbridge at Junction 2, for a distance of 700 metres in a westerly direction;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Saturday 19th July 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - a. being used for special forces purposes;
 - b. being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - c. proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
