The A638 Trunk Road, the A1 Trunk Road and the A1(M) Motorway (Redhouse Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A638 Trunk Road, the A1 Trunk Road, the A1(M) Motorway, and connecting roads, in the District of Doncaster, in the County of South Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing, road stud renewal and road marking works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A638 Trunk Road, the A1 Trunk Road and the A1(M) Motorway (Redhouse Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 16th August 2014.

2. In this Order:-

"the A638" means the A638 Trunk Road;

"the A1" means the A1 Trunk Road;

"the A1(M)" means the A1(M) Motorway;

"a connecting road" means any of the following slip roads or link roads at Redhouse Interchange:

- (i) the A1(M) northbound exit slip road;
- (ii) the A1 northbound entry slip road;
- (iii) the link road connecting the A1(M) northbound carriageway with the A638 westbound carriageway;
- (iv) the link road connecting the A638 eastbound carriageway with the A1 northbound carriageway;
- (v) the link road connecting the A1(M) northbound carriageway with the A638 eastbound carriageway; or
- (vi) the link road connecting the A638 westbound carriageway with the A1 northbound carriageway;

"the works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Sunday 17th August 2014 or any subsequent Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday night thereafter until the said works have been completed, or 14 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Saturday 23rd August 2014 or any subsequent Saturday night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a connecting road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
