The A11 Trunk Road (Barton Mills, Suffolk) (50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2014

Made - - - - *8th August 2014*
Coming into force - - *22nd August 2014*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a):

1. This Order may be cited as the A11 Trunk Road (Barton Mills, Suffolk) (50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 22nd August 2014.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on a length of the A11 Trunk Road at Barton Mills in the District of Forest Heath in the County of Suffolk, between points 376 metres south-west of the centre line of its north-eastern junction with Newmarket Road and 24 metres north-east of its junction with the north-eastern side of the A11/A1101/A1065 Fiveways Roundabout.
3. The A11 Trunk Road (Chalk Hill to Barton Mills, Suffolk) (50 Miles per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2003(b) is hereby revoked.
