ROAD TRAFFIC

The A35 Trunk Road (Honiton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A35 Trunk Road ("the A35") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and some of those connecting roads at Honiton in the District of East Devon in the County of Devon should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A35 Trunk Road (Honiton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 15th August 2014.

2. In this Order –

"the A35" means (i) the A35 Kings Road at Honiton from a point 5 metres west of its junction with Hale Lane to its roundabout junction with Honiton High Street; (ii) the A35 Monkton Road at Honiton from its junction with the Kings Road Roundabout to its junction with the A30 Monkton Exit Slip Road; (iii) the A35 Langford Overbridge at Honiton from a point 5 metres east of its junction with Langford Road to its junction with Monkton Road;

"the slip roads" mean (i) the slip road leading from the A30 westbound to the A35 Monkton Road at the Langford Junction, Honiton; (ii) the westbound entry slip road at the Langford Junction, Honiton;

"the local road" means Northcote Hill at Honiton leading to and from the A35;

"the works" mean resurfacing, patching, drainage repairs, road markings, sign repairs, loop cutting and other associated maintenance activities;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Sunday 17th August 2014 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle:

(a) to enter or proceed in the A35 and the slip roads;

(b) to enter the A35 at its junction with the local road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

(c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works;

(d) a vehicle proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the A35.
