## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A1 Trunk Road (Stretton, Rutland) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

 Made
 12th August 2014

 Coming into force
 19th August 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road ("the A1") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads, at Stretton in the County of Rutland, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Stretton, Rutland) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Tuesday 19th August 2014.
  - 2. In this Order -

"a slip road"

means the slip road leading from -

- a) the northbound carriageway of the A1 to its roundabout junction with Hooby Lane and the B668 Greetham Road; and
- b) the southbound carriageway of the A1 to its roundabout junction with Clipsham Road;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 26th August 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on a slip road.

- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
  - a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
  - c) being used in connection with the said works.
