**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A45 Trunk Road (Wootton, Northamptonshire) (Temporary  
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - *4th August 2014*

*Coming into force* - - *11th August 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads, at Wootton in the County of Northamptonshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Wootton, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 11th August 2014.

**2.** In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A45 from a point 300 metres north of the junction with High Street, to the junction with the slip road leading to Berry Lane;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A45 to the junction with Berry Lane;

“the footway” means a way comprised in a highway which also comprises a carriageway, being a way over which the public have a right of way on foot only.

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Thursday 14th August 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any pedestrian to enter or proceed in the footway adjacent to the trunk road or the slip road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of –

a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- a. being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- b. proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- c. being used in connection with the said works; and

b) article 4 shall not apply to –

- (i) any pedestrian engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activities;
- (ii) any pedestrian acting under the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) personnel engaged in the said works.
