## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A36 Trunk Road (Wilton Road, Salisbury) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road ("the A36"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Salisbury in Wiltshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Wilton Road, Salisbury) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 23rd August 2014.

2. In this Order –

"the A36" means the A36 Wilton Road in Salisbury from its junction with Australian Avenue to a point 150 metres north of its junction with Church Lane;

"the works" mean works to facilitate the resurfacing of Skew Bridge including resurfacing, drainage, white lining, loop cutting, stud replacement and survey works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 25th August 2014 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to an article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the A36 whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating "convoy working" on that road are displayed.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes; or

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

**5.** No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
