ROAD TRAFFIC

The A303 Trunk Road (Picket Twenty Interchange – Salisbury Road Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A303 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road and on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A303 Trunk Road (Picket Twenty Interchange – Salisbury Road Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 22nd February 2014.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A303 Trunk Road near Andover in the County of Hampshire;

"the length of carriageway" means the westbound carriageway of the trunk road between the exit slip road at Picket Twenty Interchange (A3093) and the entry slip road at Salisbury Road Interchange (A343);

"a slip road" means -

- (i) the road leading to the westbound carriageway of the trunk road from the A3093 at Picket Twenty Interchange,
- (ii) the road leading to the westbound carriageway of the trunk road from the A3057 at Winchester Road Interchange, or
- (iii) the road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road from the A343 at Salisbury Road Interchange;

"works" means principal and special inspections to Abbotts Ann overbridge including concrete sampling; and

"a works period" means a period of 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Tuesday 25th February 2014 or on any subsequent day until 21st August 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in length of carriageway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
