ROAD TRAFFIC

The A417 Trunk Road (A46 Shurdington Road Junction to B4070 Junction, Gloucestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 5th September 2014

Coming into force - - 8th September 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A417 Trunk Road ("the A417"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Gloucestershire should be prohibited for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16A(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A417 Trunk Road (A46 Shurdington Road Junction to B4070 Junction, Gloucestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 8th September 2014.

2. In this Order -

"the A417" means the A417 between a point at the centre of the A46 Shurdington Road Junction and a point at the centre of its junction with the B4070 near Birdlip;

"event" means the Tour of Britain cycling event;

"an event period" means a period of 4 hours starting at 11.00 hours on Wednesday 10th September 2014;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during an event period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A417.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and also when traffic will be controlled by police officers who will slow and then stop traffic for short periods until it is safe to allow drivers to proceed, and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes:
 - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

(c) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said event.
