## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A46 Trunk Road (Cold Ashton Roundabout to London Road Junction, Bath) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road ("the A46") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads in South Gloucestershire and Bath and North East Somerset should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Cold Ashton Roundabout to London Road Junction, Bath) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 8th February 2014.

2. In this Order –

"the A46" means (i) the A46 southbound from the southern edge of the A420 Cold Ashton Roundabout to the tip of the nosing of the southbound exit slip road at the A46/A4 London Road Junction, Bath; and (ii) the A46 northbound from the tip of the nosing of the northbound exit slip road at the A46/A4 London Road Junction, Bath, to the southern edge of the A420 Cold Ashton Roundabout;

"the slip road" means the northbound entry slip road at the A46/A4 London Road Junction, Bath;

"the tip of the nosing" means the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean resurfacing and the installation of new warning and vehicle activated signing;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 10th February 2014 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A46 and the slip road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance purposes;
- (d) a vehicle proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the A46.
