

“a slip road” means –

- (i) the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the motorway to the A4 (Bath Road) near Maidenhead,
- (ii) the road leading to the northbound carriageway of the trunk road from the A4 (Bath Road) near Maidenhead,
- (iii) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road to the A4 (Bath Road) near Maidenhead,
- (iv) the road leading to the southbound carriageway of the motorway from the A4 (Bath Road) near Maidenhead,
- (v) the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the trunk road to the A4130 at Burchett’s Green Interchange,
- (vi) the road leading to the northbound carriageway of the trunk road from the A4130 at Burchett’s Green Interchange,
- (vii) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road to the A4130 at Burchett’s Green Interchange,
- (viii) the road leading to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road from the A4130 at Burchetts Green Interchange,
- (ix) the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the trunk road to the A4155 at Marlow Interchange,
- (x) the road leading to the northbound carriageway of the trunk road from the A4155 at Marlow Interchange,
- (xi) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road to the A4155 at Marlow Interchange, or
- (xii) the road leading to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road from the A4155 at Marlow Interchange;

“works” means essential carriageway repairs and all associated work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Wednesday 8th October 2014 or on any subsequent day until 7th October 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle –

- (a) to enter or proceed in, or wait on, an A404 lay-by; or
- (b) to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

- (a) 10 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed; or
- (b) 40 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while the traffic signs specified in paragraph (a) of this article in relation to that length of road are not displayed.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or

(d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes;
and nothing in article 4 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
