ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5036 Trunk Road(Westbound Carriageway between the A5038 Netherton Way and Orrell Road, Litherland (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 10th September 2014

Coming into force - - 17th September 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5036 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the Borough of Sefton in Merseyside should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the A5036 Trunk Road (Westbound Carriageway between the A5038 Netherton Way and Orrell Road, Litherland) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 17th September 2014.

2. In this Order;

"trunk road" means the A5036 Trunk Road;

"works" means resurfacing, road renewal and maintenance works on the trunk road;

"the works period" means periods overnight between 2200 hours and 0500 hours (continuing to 0700 hours on Saturday and Sunday mornings) during a period starting on Thursday 18th September 2014 and ending on Friday 10th October 2014. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the length of carriageway" means the westbound carriageway of the trunk road from the centreline of the junction of the trunk road with the A5038 (Netherton Way) to the centreline of the junction of the trunk road with Orrell Road.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 12 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.

- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 12 of this Order no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to turn left from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road onto Kirkstone Road South.
- **5.** Subject as mentioned in article 12 of this Order no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to turn left from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road onto St Matthew's Avenue.
- **6.** Subject as mentioned in article 12 of this Order no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to turn left from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road onto Orrell Road.
- 7. Subject as mentioned in article 12 of this Order no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to turn left from the A5038 Netherton Way onto the westbound carriageway of the trunk road.
- **8.** Subject as mentioned in article 12 of this Order no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to turn left from Kirkstone Road South onto the westbound carriageway of the trunk road.
- **9.** Subject as mentioned in article 12 of this Order no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to turn right from Boundary Road onto the westbound carriageway of the trunk road.
- **10.** Subject as mentioned in article 12 of this Order no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to turn right from Kirkstone Road North onto the westbound carriageway of the trunk road.
- 11. Subject as mentioned in article 12 of this Order no person shall, during the works period cause or permit any vehicle to turn right from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road onto Kirkstone Road North.
- 12. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
