ROAD TRAFFIC

The M1 Motorway (Junctions 14 - 15, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 15th September 2014

Coming into force - - 22nd September 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway ("the M1") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway and two of those connecting roads, in the County of Northamptonshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junctions 14 - 15, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 22nd September 2014.

2. In this Order -

"the motorway"

means -

- a) the northbound carriageway of the M1 from the junction with the exit slip road at Junction 14, to the junction with the entry slip road at Junction 15; and
- b) the southbound carriageway of the M1 from the junction with the exit slip road at Junction 15, to the junction with the entry slip road at Junction 14;

"a slip road"

means the slip roads leading to -

- a) the northbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 14 and
- b) the southbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 15;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 23:59 hours on Saturday 27th September 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or a slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle
 - a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - c) being used in connection with the said works or by, or at the direction of, a traffic officer in uniform.
