ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Catthorpe, Warwickshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - 15th September 2014

Coming into force - - 22nd September 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road, at Catthorpe in the County of Warwickshire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Catthorpe, Warwickshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 22nd September 2014.

2. In this Order –

"the first length of trunk road"

means -

- a) the southbound carriageway of the A5 from a point 880 metres north of the centreline of its junction with Main Street, Catthorpe, to a point 120 metres south of that centreline; and
- b) the northbound carriageway of the A5 from a point 1475 metres south of the centreline of Main Street, Catthorpe, to a point 475 metres south of that centreline;

"the second length of trunk road"

means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A5 from a point 475 metres south of the centreline of Main Street, Catthorpe, to a point 120 metres south of that centreline:

"the works period"

means the period starting at 09:30 hours on Monday 29th September 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the second length of trunk road.
 - **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
 - a) being used for special forces purposes;
 - b) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - c) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
