### ROAD TRAFFIC

# The M50 Motorway (M5 Junction 8 - M50 Junction 1) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 3rd October 2014

Coming into force - - 10th October 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M50 Motorway ("the M50"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway, in the Counties of Worcestershire and Gloucestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M50 Motorway (M5 Junction 8 - M50 Junction 1) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Friday 10th October 2014.

#### 2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the westbound carriageway of the M50 from the

roundabout junction with the M5 (M5 Junction 8), to the

junction with the entry slip road at M50 Junction 1;

"the works period" means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 13th

October 2014 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the motorway.

- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
  - a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
  - c) being used in connection with the said works, or by, or with permission of, a traffic officer in uniform.
