ROAD TRAFFIC

The A52 Trunk Road (Radcliffe-On-Trent, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 6th October 2014

Coming into force - - 13th October 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road ("the A52"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Radcliffe-On-Trent in the County of Nottinghamshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Radcliffe-On-Trent, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 13th October 2014.

2. In this Order –

"bus stop area" means any area of a carriageway on a side of the trunk

road, intended for the waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1025, 1025.1, 1025.3 or 1025.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations

and General Directions 2002;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday

20th October 2014 and ending when the said works

have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the bus stop area situated adjacent to
 - a) the eastbound carriageway of the A52 30 metres east of the centrepoint of Cropwell Road junction; and
 - b) the westbound carriageway of the A52 45 metres west of the centrepoint of Cropwell Road junction.

- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A52 at its junction with
 - a) Cropwell Road north, leading to Radcliffe-On-Trent; and
 - b) Cropwell Road south, leading to Cropwell Butler.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
 - a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - c) being used in connection with the said works.
