**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A13 Trunk Road (Wennington Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - 29th September 2014

*Coming into force* - - 19th October 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A13 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A13 Trunk Road (Wennington Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 19th October 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A13 Trunk Road in the County of Essex;

“the length of carriageway” means the westbound carriageway of the trunk road between points 700 metres east and 100 metres west of the A1306 overbridge at the Wennington Interchange (A1306);

“works” mean resurfacing and all associated carriageway works being carried out by Transport for London on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 7 hours starting at 2200 hours on Tuesday 21st October 2014 or on any subsequent weekday until 18th April 2016.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
