## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A47 Trunk Road (Brundall to Acle, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A47 Trunk Road ("the A47"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Norfolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A47 Trunk Road (Brundall to Acle, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 27th October 2014.

**2.** In this Order –

"the trunk road" means the A47 from its junction with the eastern side of Cucumber Lane Roundabout, Brundall to its junction with the western side of the A1064 Old Road Roundabout, Acle;

"works" mean carriageway resurfacing and refreshment of road markings and road studs, renewal of traffic loops, traffic sign replacement, gully cleaning and landscape maintenance;

"the works period" means the period starting at 12.00 hours on Sunday 2nd November 2014 and ending when the works have been completed;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 3rd November 2014 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

"lay-by" means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(**b**); and in this definition "carriageway" means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or –

(a) proceed in the trunk road, during a works period, or

(b) wait in any lay-by adjacent to the trunk road, during the works period.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall only apply during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or in uniform, or
- (d) requiring access to or from properties which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road.
