ROAD TRAFFIC

The A47 Trunk Road (Tilney All Saints to Hardwick Interchange, Kings Lynn, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - 20th October 2014

Coming into force - - 27th October 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A47 Trunk Road ("the A47"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Norfolk, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A47 Trunk Road (Tilney All Saints to Hardwick Interchange, Kings Lynn, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 27th October 2014.

2. In this Order -

"the trunk road" means the A47 between its junctions with the eastern side of Tilney All Saints Roundabout and the western side of the A10/A149 Hardwick Road Interchange Roundabout, Kings Lynn;

"works" mean carriageway resurfacing, road markings and renewal of studs, drainage repairs, routine maintenance, gulley cleaning and landscape maintenance;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 3rd November 2014 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.
 - **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to a vehicle
 - (a) being used in connection with the works, winter maintenance or for traffic officer purposes,
 - (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,

- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or traffic officer in uniform, or
- (d) proceeding to or from properties which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road.
