ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Little Brickhill, Milton Keynes) Northbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and on some of those connecting roads in Milton Keynes should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Little Brickhill, Milton Keynes) Northbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 27th October 2014.

2. In this Order –

"tip of the nosing" means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip road joins, or the last point where an exit slip road leaves, the carriageway of the trunk road;

"the trunk road" means the northbound carriageway of the A5 from the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road leading to Watling Street, Little Brickhill to its junction with the east side of the A4146 Brickhill Street/Watling Street Roundabout (known locally as Kelly's Kitchen Roundabout);

"a slip road" means the entry slip roads to the northbound carriageway of the A5 from Woburn Road and Watling Street, Little Brickhill;

"works" mean carriageway resurfacing and renewal of road markings and road studs;

"a works period" means a period of 9 hours starting at 21.00 hours on Monday 3rd November 2014 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

(a) being used in connection with the works or for winter service maintenance,

- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
