## ROAD TRAFFIC

The A12 Trunk Road (Old London Road, Marks Tey, Colchester, Essex) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 10th February 2014

Coming into force - - 17th February 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road ("the A12"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Essex should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Old London Road, Marks Tey, Colchester, Essex) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 17th February 2014.

## 2. In this Order -

"the trunk road" means the A12 Old London Road from a point 70 metres north of the centre line of its junction with Dobbies Lane to a point 206 metres south of its junction with the A120 Coggeshall Road, Marks Tey;

"works" mean carriageway resurfacing;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 24th February 2014 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle
  - (a) being used for or in connection with the works or for winter maintenance,
  - (b) being used for, police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes,
  - (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a police constable, or a traffic officer in uniform, or
