**The A5 Trunk Road (Rye Hill, Northamptonshire) (Temporary
Restriction of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2014**

Made - - - - 24th October 2014

Coming into force - - 31st October 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Rye Hill in the County of Northamptonshire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Rye Hill, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Friday 31st October 2014.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A5 from a point 410 metres south of its junction with the B5385 Station Road for a distance of 980 metres in a south-easterly direction;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Saturday 1st November 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- a. being used for special forces purposes;
- b. being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- c. proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
