ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A590 Trunk Road (Greenodd Picnic Site) (Temporary
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - - *14th October 2014*

Coming into force - - - *2nd November 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport being the traffic authority for the A590 Trunk Road and is satisfied that traffic on sections of that trunk road in the District of South Lakeland in the County of Cumbria, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A590 Trunk Road (Greenodd Picnic Site) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 2nd November 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A590 Trunk Road;

“works” means renovation work to the toilets and picnic area;

“the first length of carriageway” means the access road to Greenodd Picnic Site car park from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road at a point 750 metres south of the centreline of the River Crake (westbound) bridge;

“the second length of carriageway” means the access road from Greenodd Picnic Site car park onto the westbound carriageway of the trunk road at a point 860 metres south from the centreline of the River Crack (westbound) bridge;

“the works period” means a period starting at 0001 hours on Monday 03 November 2014 and ending at 2359 hours on Friday 28 November 2014. However, works may start and continue beyond these dates for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first and second carriageways to be closed.

4. The provisions of articles 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a

vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.

And nothing in articles 3 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works, for winter maintenance purposes, or by traffic officers.
