### ROAD TRAFFIC

# The M1 Motorway (Junctions 22 to 21a, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 27th October 2014

Coming into force - - 3rd November 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway ("the M1") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads, in the County of Leicestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junctions 22 to 21a, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 3rd November 2014.

#### 2. In this Order -

"the motorway" means the southbound carriageway of the M1 from the

junction with the exit slip road at Junction 22, to the

junction with the entry slip road at Junction 21a;

"the slip road" means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway

of the M1 at Junction 22;

"the works period" means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 10th

November 2014 and ending when the said works have

been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -
  - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
  - (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by, or with the permission of, a traffic officer in uniform.
