ROAD TRAFFIC

The A50 Trunk Road (Sideway, Stoke on Trent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 28th October 2014

Coming into force - - 4th November 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road ("the A50") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads, near Sideway in the City of Stoke-On-Trent, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A50 Trunk Road (Sideway, Stoke on Trent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Tuesday 4th November 2014.

2. In this Order:

"the slip road" means the slip road leading from the westbound

carriageway of the A50 to the roundabout junction with Stanley Matthews Way and Tony Waddington Place;

"the works period" means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Tuesday 11th

November 2014 and ending when the said works have

been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4.	The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from
time	to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
