## ROAD TRAFFIC

# The A38 Trunk Road (Ivybridge to Ashburton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

*Made - - - - 5th November 2014* 

Coming into force - - 8th November 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road ("the A38") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and some of those connecting roads between Ivybridge and Ashburton in the County of Devon should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Ivybridge to Ashburton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 8th November 2014.

### 2. In this Order -

"the A38" means the eastbound carriageway of the A38 at the Linhay Hill junction, Ashburton between the tip of the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road and the tip of the nosing of the eastbound entry slip road;

"the slip roads" mean: (i) the westbound exit slip road at the A38 Westover Junction, Ivybridge; (ii) the eastbound entry slip road at the A38 Peartree Junction, Ashburton; (iii) the eastbound exit and entry slip roads at the A38 Linhay Hill Junction; and (iv) the eastbound exit slip road at the A38 Goodstone Cross Junction;

"the local roads" mean Whistley Hill, the unclassified road at Alston Cross and the unclassified road at Caton Cross leading to and from the eastbound carriageway of the A38 Trunk Road;

"tip of the nosing" means the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a trunk road or the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean road sign replacement and upgrading, road marking and road stud reinstatement, carriageway resurfacing and surface treatments, vehicle restraint system maintenance and improvements, drainage maintenance and improvements, soft estate maintenance, structures maintenance, network survey works and underground utility works;

"a works period" means a period of 11 hours starting at 19.00 hours on Monday 10th November 2014 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- 3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A38 and the slip roads.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the trunk road at its junctions with the local roads.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
  - (c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance purposes.
