ROAD TRAFFIC

The A47 Trunk Road (Dogsthorpe Roundabout, City of Peterborough to Guyhirn Roundabout, Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *3rd November 2014*

Coming into force - - *10th November 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A47 Trunk Road (“the A47”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road in the City of Peterborough and the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A47 Trunk Road (Dogsthorpe Roundabout, City of Peterborough to Guyhirn Roundabout, Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 10th November 2014.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the A47 between its junctions with the eastern side of the A16 Dogsthorpe Roundabout, City of Peterborough and the western side of the A141 Guyhirn Roundabout, Cambridgeshire;

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing, renewal of traffic loops, road studs and road markings, traffic sign replacement, kerbing and routine maintenance;

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 17th November 2014 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

“the works period” means the period starting at 12:00 hours on Monday 17th November 2014 and ending when the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or–

(a) proceed in the trunk road, during a works period, or

(b) wait in any lay-by adjacent to the trunk road, during the works period.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle –

(a) being used in connection with the works or winter service maintenance,

(b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,

(c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or

(d) requiring access to or from properties which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road.
