**The A52 Trunk Road (Stapleford to Bramcote,
Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of
Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *3rd November 2014*

Coming into force - - *10th November 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road (“the A52”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road, between Stapleford and Bramcote in the County of Nottinghamshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Stapleford to Bramcote, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 10th November 2014.

2. In this Order –

| “the first length of trunk road” | means the eastbound carriageway of the A52 between Bardills Roundabout and Bramcote Roundabout; |
| “the second length of trunk road” | means the westbound carriageway of the A52 between Bramcote Roundabout and Bardills Roundabout; |
| “layby” | means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the |

outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

"the works period" means the period starting at 18:45 hours on Monday 17th November 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road, the second length of trunk road, Bardills Roundabout or Bramcote Roundabout.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the first length of trunk road or the second length of trunk road.

6. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby situated adjacent to –

- a) the eastbound carriageway of the A52 approximately 690 metres east of Bardills Roundabout;
- b) the westbound carriageway of the A52 approximately –
 - i. 270 metres west of Bramcote Roundabout;
 - ii. 1670 metres west of Bramcote Roundabout.

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

8. The provisions of –

- (a) articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicle –
 - i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (b) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes; and
- (c) articles 5 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
