ROAD TRAFFIC

The A38 Trunk Road (Egginton, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 4th November 2014

Coming into force - - 11th November 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road ("the A38") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads, near Egginton in the County of Derbyshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Egginton, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Tuesday 11th November 2014.
- **2.** In this Order:

"a slip road"

means the slip roads leading -

- a) from the northbound carriageway of the A38, to the junction with the A5132 Carriers Road/The Castle Way; and
- b) to the southbound carriageway of the A38, from the junction with the A5132 Carriers Road/The Castle Way;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 21:30 hours on Tuesday 18th November 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-
 - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
 - (c) being used in connection with the said works; or
 - (d) proceeding to or from premises which are accessible from, and only from, a slip road.
