ROAD TRAFFIC

The A500 Trunk Road (Talke Roundabout, Staffordshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A500 Trunk Road ("the A500") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and some of those connecting roads, at Talke in the County of Staffordshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A500 Trunk Road (Talke Roundabout, Staffordshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Friday 31st October 2014.

2. In this Order –

"the roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A34, Peacock Hay Road and the slip roads leading to and from the A500;
"the first slip road"	means the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A500 to the roundabout;
"the second slip road"	means the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A500 to the roundabout;
"the third slip road"	means the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A500 from the roundabout;
"the fourth slip road"	means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A500 from the roundabout;

"the works period"	means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 3rd
	November 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the roundabout, the first slip road or the second slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the first slip road, the second slip road, the third slip road or the fourth slip road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the roundabout.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of –

- a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;
- b) articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
- c) articles 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
