## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A2 Trunk Road (Tollgate Junction – Pepper Hill Interchange) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2014

Made - - - - 13th January 2014

Coming into force - - 1st February 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A2 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A2 Trunk Road (Tollgate Junction – Pepper Hill Interchange) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 1st February 2014.

## 2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A2 Trunk Road in the County of Kent;

"the length of carriageway" means the westbound carriageway of the trunk road between Tollgate Junction (A227 – Wrotham Road) and Pepper Hill Interchange (B262 – Hall Road);

"works" mean surface treatment, reinstallation of road markings and all associated carriageway works on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Wednesday 5th February 2014 or on any subsequent day until 31st July 2015.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of carriageway.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- **5.** Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(**b**) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
